Services: Dial-A-Ride is a curb-to-curb transportation service, designed to serve the special transportation needs of senior citizens and individuals who have a physical or mental disability which prevents them from using the regular LOOP buses. If a person is able to use the regular LOOP bus service, they are not eligible for Dial-A-Ride.

Hours of operation: Monday – Friday 7:00am – 4:00pm

Eligibility: Individuals are eligible if they are a resident of, and have a trip origin in the towns of: Beekman, Dover, East Fishkill, Fishkill, Hyde Park, LaGrange, Pleasant Valley, Poughkeepsie, Red Hook, Rhinebeck, Union Vale, and Wappingers Falls.

Individuals are only eligible if they are 60+ years of age or have a physical or mental disability that makes it significantly difficult to do one or more of the following. The disability must be verified with a Medical Doctor's note and involve the inability to perform any of the following acts: Walk more than 200 feet, negotiate a flight of stairs, stand outside more than 10 minutes, read information due to visual impairment, get on or off a standard bus, cognitive or learning disabilities, stand on a moving bus, or hear announcements by a bus driver

An individual is not eligible for Dial-A-Ride if the disability is the result of pregnancy, obesity, controlled epilepsy, impairment due to drugs or alcohol, any contagious disease, and any disability which renders one potentially violent so as to be dangerous to oneself or other passengers .

Applications: In order to access Dial-A-Ride, an individual must have an identification card and number. To determine eligibility an application must be completed. Each individual will be notified by mail as to their eligibility status. If eligible an identification card and information on the DIAL-A-RIDE service will be mailed to them.
