**Dutchess County Statistics:**

In 2005, 84 new AIDS cases & 35 new HIV cases were diagnosed in Dutchess County, including inmate populations. (Data from CDC & NYSDOH HIV/AIDS Bureau.)  
Currently, there are 821 people living w/AIDS & 1,092 people living w/HIV, according to the Dutchess County Department of Health.

**June 27<sup>th</sup> is National HIV Testing Day!**

Every year on June 27<sup>th</sup> the National Association of People with AIDS (NAPWA) hosts a national campaign to encourage at-risk individuals to receive voluntary HIV counseling and testing. Across the country, thousands of HIV counseling and testing sites, state and local health departments, and community-based HIV/AIDS service providers will participate in National HIV Testing Day events by holding health fairs, providing community and media outreach, hosting special testing-related events or operating extended hours.

The Centers for Disease Control estimates that 180,000 to 280,000 people nationwide are HIV-positive but are unaware of their status. HIV counseling and testing enables people with HIV to take steps to protect their own health and that of their partners, and helps people who test negative get the information they need to stay uninfected.

The Dutchess County HIV Health Services Planning Council urges all individuals to get tested for HIV. Please contact the Planning Council office or any of the agencies listed on the reverse side for information about getting tested.
